IN DETAIL

SERVICES OF DR.RVSS AVADHANULU

I. Service to Mother India

1. Pioneering efforts for Digital India (Make in India concept)

Dr.RVSS Avadhanulu, belonging to first batch of computer Scientists of India, made pioneering Services from 1969 in making India to advance in Computer field. He was instrumental in Design and Development of System Software (FORTRAN computer compilers)for the first batch of Indian Computers- TDC312 and TDC 316, from ECIL, with “Make-in-India concept”.

He executed more than **70 projects of high importance**, guided **25 student projects** for their B.E.,B.Tech.,M.B.A.,M.C.A.,PGDCA etc.

Several more **Research Projects like Virtual dataspace and Rolling Arrays** were designed, developed and executed by Dr.Avadhanulu, which gave **powerful push for Digital India**.

2. Digitisation of Sanskrit and other Indian languages for the first time (1976) (Make in India concept)

Dr. Avadhanulu is the first person who successfully initiated the digitisation of Indian languages, and developed Telugu and Devanagari FORTRAN systems, in 1976. This has created new methods of communication and data composing methods in India, like E-mail and Internet, catering to millions of Indians daily. His unique contribution has attracted the appreciation of **Official Language Committee of Parliament of India in 1976**.

II. Service to Humanity

3. Design of “Vedic Mathematics in Braille script for the benefit of Blind”

Dr.Avadhanulu introduced several Numerical Techniques for fast computation of Mathematical problems, using computers.

Dr. Avadhanulu is the **first person** to take special interest and publish **Vedic Mathematics in Braille script** on purely compassionate grounds. This research product has proved to be a **novel gift to the vision challenged students**, teachers and youth of all countries, This is appreciated by all cross sections of the society, including **Shri Rameswar Thakur, former Governor of Andhra Pradesh**.

4. **Research on Predictability of Earth Quakes using Indian Astronomy.**

Dr.Avadhanulu conducted extensive research studies on Predictability of Earth Quakes using Indian Astronomy and combinations of planetary configurations. The methodology propounded by him was successfully calibrated with the astronomical data of 400 severe earth quakes.

5. **Design and Installation of Sun Dial system at Dwaraka Tirumala, West Godavari District,**

Dr.Avadhanulu took up the project of design and installation of sun dial system following the principles of ancient Indian Astronomy and Engineering, which displays time accurately. It has become a source of inspiration and motivation for several youth and students to take up the study of ancient Indian astronomy.

6. **Research in Ground water Flow Simulation Systems(1986 to 2006)**

Dr.Avadhanulu conducted extensive research studies in computerised hydrogeological systems and designed Ground water exploration and Management Software with new techniques. His research findings were published in international journals with circulation **in more than 100 countries.**

Several request letters received from several Agencies across the world including **Government of USA** reflect the significance of research carried out by Dr.Avadhanulu.

7. **World Bank Project of “Design of Computerised Surface Water Distribution System for Jaipur, for 30 years**

Dr.Avadhanulu executed a project in 1982, which involved “Design of Computerised Surface Water Distribution and management System for the city of Jaipur, Rajasthan, for planning and meeting the water requirements of Jaipur city for the next 30 years.

III. Service to Suffering Patients

8. **Design of an Integrated Patient Care & Hospital Management system at NIMS**

Dr.Avadhanulu made significant contribution in Health sector, by designing and developing Patient Care & Hospital Management system at **NIMS** (Nizam’s Institute of Medical Sciences-University-cum-super Specialty Hospital), Hyderabad, during 1986 to 2006.. As on date the database designed by him has **data of more than 2 crore patients, which will be useful for further research.**

9. **Installation of Telemedicine system**

Dr. Avadhanulu was instrumental in installation of Telemedicine system at Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences in 2002, which proved to be highly useful to poor patients from far off places of Telangana in availing the facilities of super specialty hospital, NIMS, at Hyderabad.

IV. Service to Vedas

10. **“Design of Multilingual Multimedia Database for Vedas in 1992”, for the first time in the world**

Dr. Avadhanulu is the first person to create a “Design of Multilingual Multimedia Database for Vedas in 1992”. For this, Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu was awarded the **Patent**/ Intellectual property rights by the Govt. of India (2000). His new technique has proved to be very effective in preserving the sacred texts of India, and other valuable Indian heritage for the benefit of the posterity and disseminating the Vedic knowledge throughout the globe. His successful attempt was appreciated by several scientists and scholars and also by the **President of India**, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma in 1995, who recorded his appreciation ‘**first of its kind in the world**’ through a Gazette Notification of Rashtrapati Bhavan, and also as ‘**Excellent Work**’ through his Endorsement.

11. **Digitisation of Rare Vedic Chantings for the first time in the world**

Dr. Avadhanulu digitised rare Vedic chantings for the first time – to the extent of about 3500 studio hours.

For this Dr. Avadhanulu received appreciation from the then **Prime Minister**, Shri Atal Behari Vajpayee, in April 2000. While releasing the first batch of Rigveda DVDs brought out by Dr. Avadhanulu, the Prime Minister appreciated as ‘**Indeed a dream has come to be true**’. In fact, the **website** of Shri Veda Bharathi, containing the above information, was **inaugurated** by Sri Atal Bihari Vajpayee, Prime Minister of India, on 14th April, 2000.

12. **Publication of SABDA VEDA – Great Compendium of all Veda Samhitas in a single volume**

The proposal of Dr. Avadhanulu to President of India (1995) resulted in publication of magnificent compendium of Vedic Texts of 11 Vedic Samhitas, in the form of “**Sabda Veda**”, a book with a majestic look and size of 20 inches by 15 inches by 6 inches, with about 4000 pages and a weight of about 9 kgs. This

great book was taken in procession in several states of India and also in Sydney, Melbourne and Canberra of Australia.

13. **Research in Vedic Sciences & Publications**

Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu discovered several Vedic mantras which are related to modern sciences like Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Space Science, Solar Systems and Microbiology. He also observed that many mantras have perfect correlation with modern scientific principles. Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu has brought out all those research findings in his books titled **“Science and Technology in Vedas and Sastras”**.

Dr. Avadhanulu authored about 50 books, 80 scientific papers, designed and developed DVDs of 22 titles. and about 800 episodes on Vedic Sciences in Youtube channel.

14. **Discovery of modern Computer concepts in Vedic Mimamsa sastra, for the first time**

Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu is one of the few scientists who discovered and highlighted the greatness of ancient Indian Technology. He is the first person to discover, correlate and demonstrate the concepts of computer science in ancient Vedic Mimamsa. With this he opened up a whole new world for those who are ready to push the idea further. His successful exploration of the utility of Vedic system for furtherance of modern computer technology was appreciated by the **President of India, Shri KR Narayanan, dt. 21.11.1997.**

15. **Teaching & Training Programs on “Ancient Indian Knowledge & Values”**

Dr. Avadhanulu delivered lectures on ‘Vedic Mathematics’ in Bhakti TV Channel, which got him **‘GOLDEN NANDI’ puraskar** from Government of Andhra Pradesh, with the citation that it is the “First Best Educational Programme in TV Channel” for the year 2008. His lectures on ‘Veda Vijnanam” in TTD Channel, and “Bharatiya Vignanam” in Pooja Channel, “Viswa Vijnanam” in Jaya Jaya Sankara TV Channel, and Lilavati Ganitam in SVB Channel, running into hundreds of episodes, are appreciated by lakhs of viewers as highly educative.

Dr. Avadhanulu has been conducting a series of International Teaching Programs on **“Ancient Indian Knowledge & Values”**, in which hundreds of youth from several countries are participating and learning.

V. Service to Indian Culture

16. Establishment of “SHRI VEDA BHARATHI”

Dr. Avadhanulu established “SHRI VEDA BHARATHI” (a Public Charitable Trust) for an **International Institute of Vedic Research, Development & Training**, with participation of professionals from several countries like USA, Canada, Britain, Australia, Denmark etc.

17. National Conferences

Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu organised several national conferences on scientific aspects of Vedas, and other subjects. One of them was a prestigious seminar on “**Sanskritam & Bharateeya Kalaa Vaibhavam**” at Hyderabad in 2017. About 3000 members participated and 150 delegates submitted papers in Sanskrit on Music, Dance and Drama.

18. International Vedic Conferences

Dr. Avadhanulu also organised a World Vedic Conference at Hyderabad in 1994, and also an International Vedic Conference at Srisailam in 2001, and 2019.

19. Propagation Abroad

Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu extensively toured **Australia** on Invitation and delivered Lectures in the cities of Sydney, Melbourne and Canberra on Vedic Knowledge at prestigious centres like Sydney University, Indian Embassy, etc.,

20. Publication of a Handbook for Effective Administration and Governance of Temples

Vedas on CD

A Hyderabad-based scientist has put the Vedas on computer — exploiting multimedia personal computer technology to create a user friendly access to a data base on the holy books.

Mr. R.V.S.S Avadhanulu presently deputy director (computer sciences) at the super speciality Nizam's Institute of Medical Sciences, and formerly with ECIL, has reported fruition — after two decades of work — in computerising access to the Vedas.

The system now being used by him comprises an IBM 486 PC with 8 MB RAM, 1.2 gigabytes of hard disk, a 150 MB tape drive, multimedia enhancements such as CDROM, sound and video 'blasters', and a 'GIST' card for Indian script capability.

The first segment of the project consisting of 'Krishna Yajurveda Samhita' was recently completed. The data base consists of devanagiri text of each manthra, with its identification code; 'swara' symbols; sanskrit commentary from Vidyarnya Bhashya; the English Translation of AB Keith and the telegu translation published by the Tirupati-Tirumalai Devasthanams (TID).

The system also has embedded, commentaries on the Shukla Yajurveda by Swami Dayananda Saraswathi translated into English and Lanka Venkatarama Somayaji's 'Vaidika Sarvasya' in Telegu.

Individual manthras have been deciphered and correlated with modern physics and mathematics. The GIST card helps display the text in English or any of 14 Indian languages. Multimedia capability now available with PCs was exploited to provide users with stereo recordings of the chanting of selected manthras.

Speaking to *The Hindu*, Avadhanulu, says he started the work at ECIL in 1976, and had to develop special compilers for Telugu FORTRAN in those pre-PC days, using PDP-11 mini computers. With the help of a few philanthropists who have continued to finance the project, he acquired 386 and 286 PCs for data entry and a 486 for the user front end. His current software uses 'Foxbase' under DOS but work is on to provide the data base under the industry-standard 'Windows' environment.

The President, Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, himself a vedic scholar, evinced keen interest in the project, when he inaugurated a seminar in 1992 on Vedas and Computers at Tirupati, and suggested that Avadhanulu develop 'anukramanikas' or indices for the vedas. In April this year, Avadhanulu completed this work and was invited by the President to present the results at a special session in Rashtrapati Bhavan.

Having completed the computerisation of the Yajurveda Samhita, Avadhanulu, is now working on the remaining three parts of the Yajurveda — Brahmanas, Aranyakas and Upanishads. He would like to complete the other vedas as well till an 'on-line' vedic encyclopedia is available but this needs more funding than he has been able to manage so far.— A special correspondent





A Brief Note on “SABDA VEDA” - The Grand Book of Vedas & RATHA YATRAS

INTRODUCTION

The Vedic mantras, manifested during the Samadhi state of sages, were segregated into four Vedas, viz., Rigveda, Yajurveda, Samaveda and Atharvveda, at the end of Dwapara yuga. As the capabilities of people of Kaliyuga were found to be at a highly diminished level, these four Vedas were further subdivided into **1131** branches. The details of the branches are recorded in several holy books, like Bhagavata Purana (12th Skandha) written by Sage Veda Vyasa about 5,000 years ago, Mahabhashya by Sage Patanjali about 2300 years back, and commentary of Shri Vishnu Sahasra nama stotra by Shri Adi Sankaracharya, about 1200 years back.

During the past 1000 years of foreign aggressions and alien rule, more than 99% of the above literature is lost, and only **13** branches are claimed to be available as on date. Out of these 13 claimed, actually **7** branches are being studied. It was informed that the textual parts of these branches are not available at one source. Also they are studied with limited modes of chantings, and without exploration of scientific aspects. Thus three problems are identified with regard to the Vedas, viz., with regard to the text part, with regard to different modes of chantings, and with regard to scientific aspects.

Shri Veda Bharathi under the guidance of Dr. RVSS Avadhanulu, a Nuclear Scientist, Computer professional and Vedic scholar, made attempts over the past three decades in his own way for solving the above problems.

EFFORTS FOR PRESERVATION OF “TEXT OF VEDAS”

In 1992, Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) organized an all India Vedic Conference , with Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, the then Vice President of India, as the Chief Guest. On the request of TTD, Dr. Avadhanulu developed the first prototype computerized Vedic database, with display of few mantras from Rudra Adhyaya along with their meanings in Devanagari script on the computer screen, using “C” language and “DOS” operating system. Highly pleased with the demonstration, Dr. Sharma advised Dr. Avadhanulu to develop Indexing systems for Vedas, using computer technology.

Dr. Avadhanulu completed the above task of preparing indexing systems for Taittiriya sakha of Krishna Yajurveda, and successfully demonstrated the “multilingual multimedia Vedic database” to the then President of India Dr. Shankar Dayal Sharma, in 1995. At that time **Dr. Avadhanulu submitted a proposal to the President for bringing out a grand single book, with the texts of all the available Vedic branches.** After receiving a copy of the proposal with the recommendation of the President, the then Chief minister of Rajasthan, Shri Bhairon Singh Shekavat conducted series of meetings with Shri Karpoor Chandra Kulish, Chairman of Patrika publication, Jaipur and the officials of Shri Veda Bharathi, in the last week of April, 1995, and initiated action.
